CPR / First-aid

Custom I & D - 4 Day Class
Topics: Booth carpet, custom wood exhibit installation, client interaction, exhibit dismantle and packing.

Extruded Metals I & II

Topics: Introduction to MIS, GEM, and Alusett System, custom and rental booth packages, cabinetry to entrance unit installations.

OSHA 10 Hour Course Sessions I & II

Topics: Introduction to OSHA, electrical, fall protection, forklift, and material handling, hearing protection, hand and foot protection, and fire protection.

Power Tools

Our Power Tools class consists of approximately a 1/2 hour of classroom instruction on Router's, Circular Saws and Blade Kerf's, Jig Saws, Reciprocating Saws, Hole Saws, Drill Bits and safety of all tools. The remaining time is spent in a group learning hands-on techniques such as drilling Plexi-glass, routing Plexi-glass, safe use of a Hole Saw, causes and avoidance of Saw kickbacks.

Showsite Graphics I & II

Topics: Learn the tools of the trade. Weeding, taping & application of vinyl graphics to various substrates. Vinyl repair. 3D letter application. Application of print to substrate using crop marks. Measuring techniques.
